



POSITION AVAILABLE: Post doctoral research position of Veterinary Epidemiology in Infectious Diseases.

SALARY: From 2.200 to 3.200 (net) €. Dependent on qualifications and experience.

QUALIFICATIONS: Veterinarian (DVM) and PhD degree in veterinary epidemiology are required. Demonstrated experience, productivity and creativity in research in epidemiology of animal diseases are required. Experience should include all or most of the following methods: spatial epidemiology, risk assessment and modeling, statistical methods (frequentist and/or Bayesian), social network analysis and economical analyses. Knowledge of R language, MatLab or other programming skills will be valuable. The candidate must possess excellent interpersonal and communication skills and a demonstrated ability to work with others in a collegial team atmosphere. Language: English and/or Spanish.

RESPONSIBILITIES: Supervisor of the Epidemiology working team, tutoring graduate students, development of a creative, independent, and productive basic and/or applied research program in epidemiology of animal diseases is a fundamental and indispensable requirement of the position, including publication of results in international scientific journals.
